

2008 PDCA ANNUAL MEETING AND SHOW/SALE Hastings, Nebraska July 9-11, 2008

VIDEO SHOW

This year's video contest will be judged by a Senior FFA Livestock Judging Team from Snohomish County Washington. The team is studying the Dexter Guidelines and Classification and will be providing written results of the placement of the cattle. Awards will be given to Champion and Reserve Champion Bull, Champion and Reserve Champion Cow and Best Herd. What a great way to get our youth involved!

Cattle may be shown on a halter or not. Angles and views taken must be clear and easy to see, a bad shot could make or break your animals. Mail in discs or tapes (discs are cheaper to mail) **ONE ANIMAL PER DISC OR TAPE**. Indicate the class number and animal name on tape or disc. The tapes and discs will not be mailed back, but can be picked up at the AGM in July. The PDCA reserves the right to use any or all tapes for promotional purposes.

Rules:

1. Animal must be identified in the video through signage or audio
Indicating the following:
 - A. Class
 - B. Registered Name
 - C. Registration Number
 - D. Date of Birth
 - E. Height at Shoulder (easy to measure near a reference)
 - F. Weight (can estimate)
2. **FIRST SHOT -- 30 second view of side** from approximately 20 feet
3. **SECOND SHOT -- 15 second view of at least 2 feet** (front and rear)
Animal should be on a hard surface and hooves easily seen
4. **THIRD SHOT -- 20 second rear view** from approximately 12 feet This should show the rear quarters, legs and udders or testicles.
5. **FOURTH SHOT -- 20 second front view** This should show the head, shoulders and front legs
6. **FINAL SHOT -- 30 seconds of animal on the move.** Animal should be at a brisk walk to show it's ease of travel. Try to take in a clockwise direction at a side view (not running away camera shy!)

The entire video should not exceed 2 ½ minutes. Include a completed entry form with your entries.
