INFORMATION FOR NEW MEMBERS

Tattoo Information

The tattoo letter for 2004 will be "P", it will be "R" for 2005, and "S" for 2006. Most breeders use this in the following manner. The letter of their farm, the number of the calf for the year and then the Association letter. An example would be for the Sho-Me Farm:

S3S

The "S" would be the farm letter, the "3" would be the third calf born in 2006 and "S" would be the Association letter.

Normally the custom is for members to be responsible for seeing that the paperwork is completed for any animal they sell -- this would include the transfer fee. This is done on an individual basis and not all members do this. However, the Association would like to encourage sellers to do so to help the new owner (especially if this is the individual's first Dexter).

If you have any questions on transfers or registrations, please feel free to contact your Association secretary.

Fees for registration of animals for Members are as follows:

Cows up to one-year-old	\$20
Transfer Fees: Regular	\$20
Bulls up to 2 years old	\$20
Inner-herd transfer	\$10
Cows over 1 year old	\$40 (regardless of age)
Bulls over 2 years old	\$40

Registrations and transfer fees for non-members is double.

The procedure for registering cattle to the PDCA with existing ADCA registrations is to send in a copy of the registration paper(s) with a fee of \$5 per farm for 1-25 animals and \$10 for 26+ animals to cover postage.
